Activity

- 1. Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA.
- 2. Immobilized recombinant Mouse RTN4R at 2 μ g/ml (100 μ l/well) can bind biotinylated human RTN4 (GST Tag) with a linear range of 0.04-0.625 μ g/ml.

Molecular Mass

The secreted mature form of mouse RTN4R consists of 432 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 47 kDa. Due to glycosylation, rmRTN4R migrates as an approximately 65 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- $1.\,5$ % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
