A DNA sequence encoding the extracellular domain of influenza A virus hemagglutinin (A/chicken/Alabama/1/1975 (H4N8)) (P19695) (Met 1-Ile528) was fused with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

(A/chicken/Alabama/1/1975(H4N8)) comprises 523 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 59 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, it migrates as an approximately 75 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

Storage

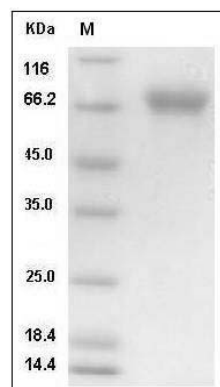
Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C .

It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
