A DNA sequence encoding the Influenza A virus (A/Fort Monmouth/1/1947) (H1N1) hemagglutinin (ABD77807.1) (Met1-Arg344), termed as HA1, was expressed with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

The recombinant HA1 subunit of the Influenza A virus (A/Fort Monmouth/1/1947) (H1N1)

hemagglutinin consists of 338 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 38.1 kDa.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4.

1. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization. Specific concentrations are included in the hardcopy of COA.

Usage Guide

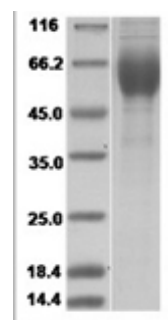
Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C . It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
