The recombinant HA1 subunit of Influenza B virus (B/Florida/4/2006) hemagglutinin comprises 357 amino acids with the predicted molecular mass of

39 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, it migrates as an approximately 50-60 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
