A DNA sequence encoding the canine BMPR1A (NP_001138622.1) (Met1-Arg152) was expressed with the Fc region of human IgG1 at the C-terminus.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4.

Usage Guide

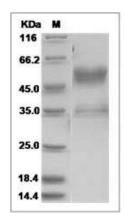
Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
