Preservative: 0.05% Sodium Azide.

Store at +4°C after thawing. Aliquot store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze / thaw cycles.

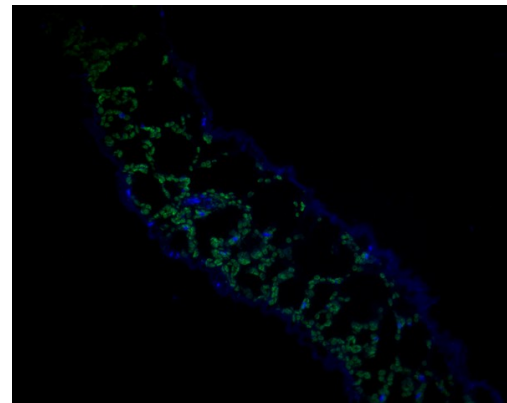
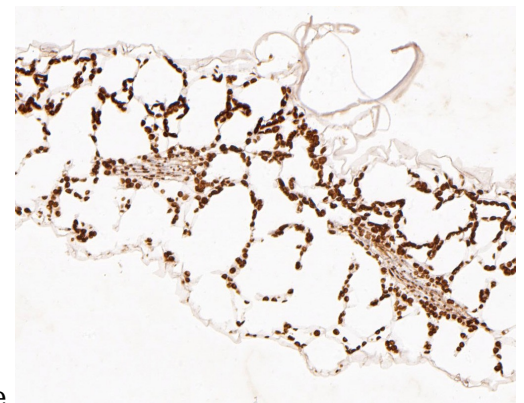


Fig1:: Immunofluorescence staining of paraffin-embedded A. thaliana using anti-AtGLP7 rabbit polyclonal antibody. The section was pre-treated using heat mediated antigen retrieval with Tris-EDTA buffer (pH 9.0) for 20 minutes. (sodium citrate buffer (pH6) for 20 mins.) The tissues were blocked in 10% negative goat serum for 1 hour at room temperature, washed with PBS, and then probed with 175776# at 1/50 dilution for 10 hours at 4°C and detected using Alexa Fluor® 488 conjugate-Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) Secondary Antibody at a dilution of 1:500 for 1 hour at room



temperature.

Fig2:: Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded A. thaliana tissue using anti-AtGLP7 antibody. The section was pre-treated using heat mediated antigen retrieval with Tris-EDTA buffer (pH 8.0-8.4) for 20 minutes. The tissues were blocked in 5% BSA for 30 minutes at room temperature, washed with ddH₂O and PBS, and then probed with the primary antibody (1/200) for 30 minutes at room temperature. The detection was performed using an HRP conjugated compact polymer system. DAB was used as the chromogen. Tissues were counterstained with hematoxylin and

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mounted with DPX.
